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1. PENSION FUND ANNUAL REPORT

- 1.1. Under the Local Government Pension Scheme (Administration) Regulations 2008, local authorities are required to prepare and make available an annual report of the pension fund for which they have responsibility by 1 December following the previous 31 March year end.
- 1.2. The proposed Annual Report for the City of Westminster Pension Fund is attached as Appendix 1. The content of the report has to meet certain requirements as set out in the Regulations and it is the view of officers that the Annual Report meets these requirements.
- 1.3. This Annual Report still requires formal sign-off from the auditors. Officers do not expect there to be any material changes to the report before that signature. In the event that there are material changes (in the view of the Chief Operating Officer), the Annual Report will be brought back to the Committee for subsequent approval.
- 1.4. The Committee is asked to approve the Annual Report (which includes summary financial information taken from the draft statement of accounts), subject to the paragraph above and the Audit & Performance Committee approving the Council's Statement of Accounts (which includes the Pension Fund's Statement of Accounts) at its meeting at the end of September.
