1. Summary

- 1.1 This report seeks approval for the expenditure of £10,199.46 from the Lancaster Gate Ward Budget in order to commission:
 - Queensborough Terrace renovation project:
 - o Build a small wall to create a permanent planting area along the kerb line of Queensborough Terrace
 - o Install a new lantern on the newly built wall
 - o Resurface underneath the arch and along the immediate kerb line of Queensborough Terrace
 - o Start the consultation process for a zebra crossing on Queensborough Terrace

Recommendation

That the Cabinet Member for Environment, Sports and Community approves expenditure of £10,199.46 in respect of the above proposal detailed in the report.

1. Background Information

- 1.1 Ward budgets were established under the City Council's Neighbourhood Programme agreed by the Cabinet in November 2007. The extension to the ward budget programme was agreed in March 2010 for continuation until March 2014.
- 1.2 The renewal of the ward budget programme for the years 2014-2018 was agreed in June 2014.
- 1.3 Budget provision of £46,000 for the financial year 2017/18 exists to fund ward based projects.

2. Proposed Projects

£10,199.46 will fund part of the Queensborough Terrace renovation project. This project is already underway and WCC Highways are seeking additional funds for part of the project (as specified in the Summary above). Lancaster Gate has already part funded some aspects of the Queensborough Terrace renovation project in the 2016/17 financial year for temporary planters whilst the larger consultation process was carried out by WCC Highways. These additional funds (as outlined in this report) will contribute to more permanent changes on Queensborough Terrace.

3. Financial Implications

- 3.1 Expenditure and approvals in process from the Lancaster Gate budget to date total £120,066.14 leaving £63,933.86 to be allocated.
- 3.2 The proposals for expenditure in this report amount to £10,199.46 and leaves £26,354.80 available for future allocation.

4. Legal Implications

4.1 Section 1 of the Localism Act, aka "the general power of competence" enables authorities "to do anything that individuals generally may do". The proposals within this report are consistent with the Council exercising this power.

5. Outstanding Issues

5.1 There are no outstanding issues.

6. Consultation

- 6.1 The proposals have been agreed by all Councillors from all wards involved.
- 6.2 The proposal for Queensborough Terrace renovation project has been drawn up and verified following consultation with WCC Highways and the Council's Finance and Legal Services Departments.

7. Equalities

7.1 The proposals in this report will support the Council's wider equalities and diversity agenda by focusing on addressing local issues with enhanced local engagement.
