Reasons for Decision

Renovation of the Seymour Leisure Centre has been considered for a number of years. The council have committed to the relocation of Marylebone Library from its current leasehold base to a permanent new home within the Seymour Centre.

In order to progress the project now it is necessary to appoint engineers and other professional services in order to progress the analysis of options currently being worked up for the Centre.
