We have been residents since 1996 at flat 61 Queens Court north. Our flat is on the second floor, facing west, directly above Taza restaurant.

Our main objection to Taza is the smell pollution. We are only able to open our windows between the hours of midnight and ten o'clock in the morning. At other times the smell of cooking is too pronounced. In the summer this is even more intolerable. We have complained to the restaurant in the past on a number of occasions and they have pointed out the metal food extractor tunnel leading from their restaurant to above the roof. The benefit of this extractor fan is negated as they have their windows open most of the year and in warmer weather their door is also open.

Our sleep is already disturbed by the cooking smell lingering well into the night quite apart from the general noise made by the staff clearing up and speaking on their mobile phones. Extending their licence would be downright unkind.
