Annex 1 – Mandatory conditions

1. No supply of alcohol may be made at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of this licence.
2. No supply of alcohol may be made at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or the personal licence is suspended.
3. Every supply of alcohol under this licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.
4.
 - (1) The responsible person shall take all reasonable steps to ensure that staff on relevant premises do not carry out, arrange or participate in any irresponsible promotions in relation to the premises.
 - (2) In this paragraph, an irresponsible promotion means any one or more of the following activities, or substantially similar activities, carried on for the purpose of encouraging the sale or supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises in a manner which carries a significant risk of leading or contributing to crime and disorder, prejudice to public safety, public nuisance, or harm to children
 - (a) Games or other activities which require or encourage, or are designed to require or encourage, individuals to
 - (i) Drink a quantity of alcohol within a time limit (other than to drink alcohol sold or supplied on the premises before the cessation of the period in which the responsible person is authorised to sell or supply alcohol), or
 - (ii) Drink as much alcohol as possible (whether within a time limit or otherwise);
 - (b) provision of unlimited or unspecified quantities of alcohol free or for a fixed or discounted fee to the public or to a group defined by a particular characteristic (other than any promotion or discount available to an individual in respect of alcohol for consumption at a table meal, as defined in section 159 of the Act);
 - (c) Provision of free or discounted alcohol or any other thing as a prize to encourage or reward the purchase and consumption of alcohol over a period of 24 hours or less;
 - (d) Provision of free or discounted alcohol in relation to the viewing on the premises of a sporting event, where that provision is dependent on
 - (i) The outcome of a race, competition or other event or process, or
 - (ii) The likelihood of anything occurring or not occurring;
 - (e) Selling or supplying alcohol in association with promotional posters or flyers on, or in the vicinity of, the premises which can reasonably be considered to condone, encourage or glamorise anti-social behaviour or to refer to the effects of drunkenness in any favourable manner.
5. The responsible person shall ensure that no alcohol is dispensed directly by one person into the mouth of another (other than where that other person is unable to drink without assistance by reason of a disability).
6. The responsible person shall ensure that free tap water is provided on request to customers where it is reasonably available.

7.
 - (1) The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder shall ensure that an age verification policy applies to the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.
 - (2) The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and a holographic mark.
8. The responsible person shall ensure that
 - (a) Where any of the following alcoholic drinks is sold or supplied for consumption on the premises (other than alcoholic drinks sold or supplied having been made up in advance ready for sale or supply in a securely closed container) it is available to customers in the following measures
 - (i) Beer or cider: ½ pint;
 - (ii) Gin, rum, vodka or whisky: 25 ml or 35 ml; and
 - (iii) Still wine in a glass: 125 ml; and
 - (b) Customers are made aware of the availability of these measures.

A responsible person in relation to a licensed premises means the holder of the premise licence in respect of the premises, the designated premises supervisor (if any) or any individual aged 18 or over who is authorised by either the licence holder or designated premises supervisor. For premises with a club premises certificate, any member or officer of the club present on the premises in a capacity that which enables him to prevent the supply of alcohol.

Annex 3 – Conditions attached after a hearing by the licensing authority

9. A proof of age scheme, such as Challenge 21, shall be operated at the premises where the only acceptable forms of identification are recognised photographic identification cards, such as a driving licence or passport.
10. An incident log shall be kept at the premises, and made available on request to an authorised officer of the City Council or the Police, which will record the following:
 - (a) all crimes reported to the venue
 - (b) all ejections of customers
 - (c) any complaints received
 - (d) any incidents of disorder
 - (e) seizures of drugs or offensive weapons
 - (f) any faults in the CCTV system or searching equipment or scanning equipment
 - (g) any refusal of the sale of alcohol
 - (h) any visit by a relevant authority or emergency service.
11. The means of escape provided for the premises shall be maintained unobstructed, free of trip hazards, be immediately available and clearly identified in accordance with the plans provided.
12. The edges of the treads and steps and stairways shall be maintained so as to be conspicuous.
13. Curtains and hangings shall be arranged so as not to obstruct emergency signs or emergency equipment.
14. The supply of alcohol at the premises shall only be to a person seated taking a table meal there and for consumption by such a person as ancillary to their meal.
15. The supply of alcohol at the premises shall be by waiter or waitress service only.
16. Substantial food and non-intoxicating beverages, including drinking water, shall be available throughout the permitted hours in all parts of the premises where alcohol is sold or supplied for consumption on the premises.
17. Alcohol consumed in the external area shall only be consumed by customers seated at tables.
18. No entertainment, performance, service, or exhibition involving nudity or sexual stimulation which would come within the definition of a sex establishment in Schedule 3 to the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1982 as amended by the Greater London Council (General Powers) Act 1986 (whether or not locally adopted), shall be provided.
19. No striptease, no nudity and all persons to be decently attired at all times.
20. Tables and chairs in the external area shall be rendered unusable for customers from 23.00 hours on Monday to Saturday and 22:30 hours on Sunday.
21. Notices shall be prominently displayed at any area used for smoking requesting customers to respect the needs of local residents and use the area quietly.
22. No noise shall emanate from the premises nor vibration be transmitted through the structure of the premises which gives rise to a nuisance.
23. Loudspeakers shall not be located in the entrance lobby or outside the premises building.

24. After 21:00 hours all entrance doors and windows to be kept closed except for immediate access and egress of persons.
25. Notices shall be prominently displayed at all exits requesting customers to respect the needs of local residents and leave the area quietly.
26. The venue will install and maintain a comprehensive CCTV system as per the minimum requirements of a Metropolitan Police Crime Prevention Officer. All entry and exit points will be covered enabling frontal identification of every person entering in any light condition. The CCTV system shall continually record whilst the venue is open for licensable activities for a period of 31 days with date and time stamping. Recordings shall be made available, immediately upon the request of Police or authorised officer throughout the preceding 31 days.
27. A staff member from the premises who is conversant with the operation of the CCTV system shall be on the premises at all times when the premises is open to the public. This staff member shall be able to show Police recent data or footage with the absolute minimum of delay when requested.
28. The pavement from the building line to the kerb edge immediately outside the premises, including gutter/channel at its junction with the kerb edge, is swept and or washed, and litter and sweepings collected and stored in accordance with the approved refuse storage arrangements.
29. All waste is to be properly presented and placed out for collection no earlier than 30 minutes before the scheduled collection times.
30. No rubbish including bottles will be moved, removed or placed in outside areas between 23:00 hours and 08:00 hours.
31. There shall be no sales of hot food or hot drink for consumption off the premises after 23:00 hours.
32. The number of persons permitted in the premises at any one time (excluding staff) shall not exceed;

Ground Floor: 48 (32 indoors and 16 outdoors)
First Floor: 130.
33. All windows at 1st floor level to be closed after 21:00 hours.
34. There shall be no deliveries to the premises before 08:00 or after 20:00 hours on any day.
35. There shall be no service to customers outside the premises after 21:00 hours.
36. Patrons shall be directed to leave the premises via Upper St Martin's Lane after 21:00 hours.
37. Patrons permitted to temporarily leave and then re-enter the premises shall be limited to 15 persons at any one time.
38. The Licence Holder shall ensure that queuing takes place indoors only.
