

Sixes, 170 Great Portland Street, London

Proposed Conditions

1. In the cross hatched area, the supply of alcohol at the premises in the area cross hatched on the plan shall only be to a person seated taking a table meal there, and consumption by such a person as ancillary to their meal, to people who are taking part in an experiential experience, or to people attending a bona fide pre-booked function [condition offered in the application to replace condition 23].
2. There will be no more than 8 tables and 16 chairs outside in the area edged green on the plan, and those tables and chairs shall be removed or rendered unusable after 22:00 [amendment to existing condition 27].
3. The supply of alcohol at the premises in the area outlined green in the basement will only be to persons who are attending a pre-booked function or event, and will not be otherwise available to the general public [condition offered in the application].
4. The maximum number of customers permitted in the area outlined in green in the basement will be no more than 20 [new proposed condition].
5. The double doors between the cross hatched area and the remainder of the premises will remain closed (other than for access / egress between the areas) at all times when licensable activities are taking place in the area which is cross hatched [new proposed condition].
6. The doors which provide egress from the cross hatched area to Great Portland Street will only be used as a fire exit, and will not be used by the public either to access or egress the premises at any time by customers, other than in the event of an emergency.
7. The entrance doors to the left of the premises as one looks at it from Great Portland Street, which give access / egress from and to Great Portland Street to customers, will not open from the inside due to sensors from people moving about. The doors can only be opened from the inside by a push pad located within the premises.
